

Monroe Central School Corporation COVID Plan 2021-2022



(Revised - September 14, 2021)

- Masks are optional in school buildings and on school grounds (masks are required by federal CDC order on all school buses)
- Unvaccinated individuals identified as a close contact must quarantine as directed by Governor Holcomb's Executive Order
- Promote good hygiene practices like hand washing, covering coughs, etc.
- Provide hand sanitizer at entrances and in the cafeterias
- Water bottles will be encouraged and no sharing will be permitted
- All staff and students are encouraged to self-screen each day monitor symptoms
- Supplemental cleaning will take place as needed including disinfecting of high touch surfaces such as door handles, light switches, handrails and faucet handles.
- More restrictive measures will be implemented if substantial spread is determined at Monroe Central School Corporation. Those measure
 may include:
 - Maximize instructional space. Desks are separated as much as possible. All desks face the same direction
 - Limit large group gatherings Discourage the congregation of students in common areas / limit spectators at extracurricular activities
 - Minimize the use of shared supplies and materials
 - Restrict visitors and guests in school buildings
 - All study trips will be postponed
 - Deep cleaning procedures conducted by custodial staff at the direction of the Director of Operations or Designee
